The abstract text should not exceed **300** characters. It should be font Arial, point 11. You could copy the abstract and paste it to the form. (not exceed 1 page)

The abstracts should be in order of **INTRODUCTION/ PURPOSE, MATERIALS and METHOD, FINDINGS, DISCUSSION / CONCLUSION** and case report abstract submission should be in order of **INTRODUCTION/ PURPOSE, FACT, DISCUSSION/ CONCLUSION**.

Please submit your abstract according to the required order. Please do not enter the author and institute names in abstract boxes.

Abstract submission deadline is **5 April 2015**. Abstract form requires a user membership. If you do not have any membership, you could have a new account by filling the form. An activation link will be sent to your email address. This link can be detected as spam in some email addresses. Please consider this information.

If you would like to submit more than one abstract, you should send all abstracts from same accounts.
