### Kuching Heritage City Tour

<b>Duration</b>	3 hours +-

<b>Tour Description</b>	<p>Kuching, the capital of Sarawak, is a cosmopolitan city, and this is reflected in the faces on the street. Its city centre is well preserved, with ornate houses of worship such as the Kuching State Mosque and Tua Pek Kong Temple, as well as many fine examples of colonial-style architecture, including the Square Tower, which stands alongside the historical Astana and Fort Margherita, the ultramodern State Legislative Assembly building (DUN), and the Golden Bridge, overlooking the Kuching Waterfront. The iconic cat statue strategically dotted along the city centre, a symbol of Kuching City's mascot, will greet you along the way as your tour takes you to the Market, Main Bazaar, China Town, and other well-known city landmarks, including the Borneo Cultural Museum, among other places of interest.</p> 



### Semenggoh Wildlife Centre

<b>Tour Description</b>	<p>Unlike in a zoo, the orangutans are free to roam in this 653-hectare forest reserve. Young and adolescent orangutans are trained here to be self-sufficient in the wild. Observe their delicate nests, as well as their deft movements in the treetops and fascinating feeding behaviour. The guide will also explain the behaviour and characteristics of this unique primate known as the orangutan, or "man of the forest".</p>

<b>Tour Description</b>	<p>The Village, also known as the "Living Museum," is a kaleidoscope of Sarawak's cultures and traditions. Upon arrival, explore the seven authentic replicas of ethnic houses, including the Chinese Farm House, Malay's Stilted House, Melanau Tall House, Penan Hut, and Longhouses of the Iban, Bidayuh, and Orang Ulu ethnic groups. The many artefacts created by the individual dwellers are displayed in each house. While touring the village, you can see arts and crafts demonstrations like beadwork, wood and bamboo carvings, "Pua" weaving, and straw weaving. Enjoy the visual treat of a cultural extravaganza performance by various ethnic groups at the Village Theatre.</p>

Take in the sights of the Waterfront, Brooke Dockyard, the 100-year-old Malay Kampung, Fort Margherita, Astana, Square Tower, colourful fishing boats that dotted the riverbanks and the mansions of Kuching's affluent society. <b>Tour Description</b>	<p>Bako National Park is Sarawak's oldest and most popular national park, providing the ideal introduction to the state's forest and wildlife. It has diverse vegetation, jungle streams, waterfalls, interesting plant life, trekking trails, and coastlines with small bays, coves, and beaches. Visitors can see wildlife such as proboscis monkeys, long-tailed macaques, Borneo bearded pigs, and monitor lizards. You will be able to see almost desert-like scrub, or "padang," on the plateau and lowland dipterocarp forest. Erosion has left some spectacular sandstone formations, such as the well-known Sea Stack.</p>   
<b>Note</b>	Recommended Trail: Paku Trail. Please keep in mind that the park guide will assess your fitness level and interests before recommending the best trail.
